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## SUMMER E. STAHL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (EST. 2024)

### INTRODUCTION

The Stahl family, in collaboration with the Deer Creek - Mackinaw Education Foundation (DCMEF), is pleased to offer the Summer E. Stahl Memorial Scholarship. A \$2,000.00 scholarship will be awarded to the successful applicant beginning in the Spring of 2024 and will be for the benefit of students who have graduated from Deer Creek-Mackinaw High School. The Stahl family has established this annual scholarship in Summer's memory to honor her life.

### AWARD

The Summer E. Stahl Memorial Scholarship of \$2,000 will be awarded annually in the spring. Applicants shall include students graduating from Deer Creek-Mackinaw High School who will be entering college or trade schools immediately after graduation or former students already enrolled in college or trade school who are finishing their undergraduate degree programs. The award will be made directly to the college/university or trade school by the fall semester of the successful candidates' academic year.

### APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Each applicant will be required to submit the following:

1. A completed Summer E. Stahl Scholarship Application Form.
2. Their high school and/or college transcript.
3. A work and extra-curricular activity resume.
4. Submission of an original essay responding to the question, "What constitutes being a well-rounded person and why does being a well-rounded person matter?". Further the essay should be typed; double spaced, and not exceed 1000 words in length.

### APPLICATION DEADLINE

Applications should be submitted to DCMEF in the year of the candidate's graduation from Deer Creek - Mackinaw High School or while enrolled in an accredited undergraduate degree program or trade school. All application materials must be received no later than **April 22nd** and must be mailed to the Deer Creek - Mackinaw Education Foundation, P.O. Box 621, Mackinaw, IL 61755. ### CRITERIA

The successful candidate will be determined by completion of the application and submission of the essay. The applicants must be a graduate of Dee-Mack High School.

### SELECTION COMMITTEE

The selection committee will consist of the Deer Creek-Mackinaw Education Foundation Board of Directors as well as a representative of the Stahl family. The final decision for the scholarship award will

be made at the sole discretion of the selection committee and the Stahl family and will be based on a review of the application subject to the stated criteria. As such, an applicant has no guarantee of an award, in full or in part.
